

Amsterdam electric vehicle costs

Charging and parking electric vehicles. You need a pass to charge your electric vehicle at public charging points and you must pay the standard parking charges, if applicable. Amsterdam's electric vehicle charging points can be viewed on a map. Electric cars get priority on the parking permit waiting list.

It costs EUR3.46 to charge an electric vehicle in Amsterdam. If you are charging an electric vehicle once a day, it will cost you a total of EUR103.8 per month. If you decide to charge your electric vehicle every 2nd day, you would save EUR51.90.

How much does it cost to charge my electric car in Amsterdam? Just as you look for the price of a liter or gallon of gas with a combustion engine car, the main determining factor of how much your EV will cost to charge is the price per kilowatt-hour (kWh) of electricity.

Peak and off-peak prices: you pay different price per kWh based on the time of day you use the charger. Operators or owners may use this to pass on the fluctuating cost of energy throughout the day. Starting fee: you pay a price per session to plug in your car.
