C?te d'Ivoire, March 28, 2024 - TotalEnergies has teamed up with Roxgold SANGO SA, a subsidiary of Fortuna Silver Mines Inc., to develop a ground-mounted solar power plant at the S?gu?la gold mine, in C?te d'Ivoire.

TotalEnergies is supporting Roxgold SANGO SA in its energy transition with the construction of a 6 MWp (megawatt peak) solar power plant. With an estimated production capacity of around 11.7 GWh (gigawatt-hours) per year, the solar power plant will cover around 30% of the S?gu?la mine's energy needs.

TotalEnergies offers attractive energy solutions tailored to all areas of activity, both for the private sector - in particular the mining, cement, retail and agri-food sectors - and for the public sector, to support their decarbonization.

As a major player in the development, construction and operation of solar energy production systems, TotalEnergies supports its industrial and commercial customers in their energy transition by producing renewable electricity directly on their sites.
