During COVID-19, Paris made major strides toward sustainable mobility, launching its public EV charging network called Belib". This reflects the growing number of EV registrations in Paris, which increased by a whopping 41% from 2020 to 2021.

There are currently around 2,300 public EV charging stations in Paris, operated under the city's Belib''public EV charging scheme. This doesn't include any private EV charging stations or charge points installed by hotels, restaurants, shopping centers, or workplaces for use by their customers or employees.

Paris" municipal Belib" network has EV chargers installed across the city. Belib" chargers are usually located in on-street parking bays, although many parking garages owned by the city are also equipped with public charging stations. This includes the Saemes Madeleine-Tronchet underground parking garage in the 8th Arrondissement, the largest public charging location in France with over 505 charging stations.

Other major parking garages, including Porte d"Auteuil and Jean-Bouin in the 16th Arrondissement, as well as Saint-Augustin Bergson in the 8th Arrondissement, are all EV charging hubs with dozens of charging stations.

There are three tariffs on Paris" Belib" network depending on your situation, with EV charging either billed by the minute, the kilowatt-hour, or both. The subscription for residents and non-residents costs EUR7 per year. Alternatively, you also have the option to pay as you go on the resident tariff. Visitors
