Givenergy and octopus

One of the reasons we were drawn to the GivEnergy system was a comprehensive API that I knew could become useful in the future with home automation, smart tariffs and the like. Thankfully Octopus are very forward-thinking in this regard too so I've been able to sign up for Octopus R& D Labs which will also interface with Tado, Solar Edge, nCube and many more.

I seem to have failed on the first step. After signing in to Octopus R& D I can only see "Graphs" and "My Account". I have tried on both an Android and iPhone but I don't see "Devices".

I'm only on the Flux import tariff for the time being whilst I wait for export to be set up as my GivEnergy 5kW Gen3 hybrid inverter + batteries were only commissioned on 08/08/2023. I'm not sure if this makes a difference? Any help would be much appreciated.

Hi Alun. Thanks for this. I've managed to set up my Givenergy inverter on the R& D site. The rules setup suggests that the holy grail can be achieved: discharging the battery down to a set minimum and time (say for Octopus Flux 4-7pm), then restore the 'Eco' mode (which can't be done through the Givenergy App because its stays on battery hold)?I've done a test but it didn't reset to eco mode (even though it claimed it had) and stays on battery hold.ThanksMichael
