Porto novo electricity rates

A normal LV electricity consumer (contracted power less than or equal to 41.4 kVA) can choose between 3 tariff options. Each period has different energy prices: Tri-hourly: 3 periods during the day (peak hours, mid-peak hours, and off-peak hours)

Summary of cost of living in Porto, Portugal: A family of four estimated monthly costs are 2,551.4\$ (2,449.0EUR) without rent (using our estimator). A single person estimated monthly costs are 721.7\$ (692.7EUR) without rent. Porto is 57.9% less expensive than New York (without rent, see our cost of living index).

Currently, the cheapest electricity tariff in Portugal is Casa, by Iberdrola. However, when comparing the electricity prices, there is also very close competition between the prices offered by EDP, Endesa and Goldenergy in Portugal.

It costs EUR0.74 to shower for 10 minutes in Porto. If you are showering for 10 minutes once a day, it will cost you a total of EUR22.2 per month. If you decide to reduce showers to 5 minutes, you would save EUR11.10.

It costs EUR0.93 to have a bath in Porto. If you are taking a bath once a day, it will cost you a total of EUR27.9 per month. If you decide to reduce number of baths from every day to every 2nd day, you would save EUR13.95.

It costs EUR5.58 to charge an electric vehicle in Porto. If you are charging an electric vehicle once a day, it will cost you a total of EUR167.4 per month. If you decide to charge your electric vehicle every 2nd day, you would save EUR83.70.

It costs EUR0.10 to run the washing machine in Porto. If you are running the washing machine once a day, it will cost you a total of EUR3 per month. If you decide to running the washing machine every 2nd day, you would save EUR1.50.

It costs EUR0.04 to vacuum for 10 minutes in Porto. If you are vacuuming for 5 minutes once a day, it will cost you a total of EUR1.2 per month. If you decide to vacuum every 2nd day, you would save EUR0.60.

It costs EUR0.04 to use a hairdryer for 10 minutes in Porto. If you are using a hairdryer for 10 minutes once a

day, it will cost you a total of EUR1.2 per month. If you decide to use the hairdryer for 5 minutes, you would save EUR0.60.

It costs EUR0.07 to watch 1 hour of TV in Porto. If you are watching 1 hour of TV once a day, it will cost you a total of EUR2.1 per month. If you decide to reduce tv usage by 2 hours a day, you would save EUR1.05.

Electricity prices are divided into different zones because each area has different supply and demand conditions and transmission capabilities. Some countries have multiple zones to ensure prices reflect the true cost of delivering electricity to each region, influenced by local policies and grid infrastructure. The graphs and tables in this article displays the electricity prices for the region(s) in Porto.
