Public private partnerships (PPPs) emerged as a widely used governance arrangement in the past couple of decades (Wang et al. 2018). Understood, broadly, as a form of collaboration between public and private actors, PPPs have become a recent source of economic pressure and political concern for many governments. Despite their potential gains ascribed by the literature, the empirical evidence concerning PPPs good performance is fuzzy at best (Hodge and Greve 2017).
