

Rabat australia solar power

Rabat - Morocco and Australia are rising world powers as regards renewable energies and green hydrogen, Australian Ambassador to the Kingdom, Michael Cutts, said on Thursday in Rabat.

Speaking at a ceremony held to commemorate Australia's national holiday "Australia Day 2024", Cutts underlined the solid ties between Australia and Morocco, whose diplomatic relations are now celebrating their 47th anniversary.
