

Solar energy policy tripoli

The training, GIZ reported, was divided into two parts, both held in Tunis. The first session took place in July and the second session occurred in November. The 17 engineers were trained to extract resource data on Libya from Solar Atlas and developed the skills to set up and collect data themselves on irradiance from measurement stations (the amount of sunlight measured at certain locations).

The workshops were supported by Germany's BMZ through the project "Support for Renewable Energies in Libya (SREL)". It is implemented by GIZ in cooperation with the Prime Minister's Office of Libya and REAoL.
