

## Tashkent energy storage companies

In the beginning of 2021, Aksa Energy also signed a 30-year concession agreement regarding the operating rights of a natural gas power plant with an installed capacity of 50 MW in the Republic of Congo.

On 21 January 2021, Aksa Enerji ?retim A.?'s 100% subsidiary Aksa Energy Company Congo has signed a concession agreement with Republic of Congo about obtaining operating rights of a 50 MW natural gas power plant in the city of Pointe-Noire.

Natural gas is expected to be supplied from Congo's local gas reserves. Electricity generated is expected to be exported to Democratic Republic of Congo via existing transmission lines.
