When used appropriately, yes. This means charging only the supported rechargeable batteries to ensure they're receiving the correct voltage and current. Reliable, modern chargers like the ones on this list also employ several safety features, like "smart charging" functions to cut off the power when a battery is detected to be complete, damaged, or running too hot. This helps prevent problems that come with batteries overcharging or overheating.

Generally, yes--as long as they are the type of rechargeable battery the charger is designed for, any battery brand should work with that charger. It's still best to charge batteries of similar types, sizes, and charge levels together, particularly with chargers that charge batteries in pairs.

It can be expected for rechargeable batteries to get somewhat warm during the charging process, especially with a fast charger using a higher charging current. If the batteries or any part of the charger becomes noticeably hot, you should stop charging and check for issues with the batteries or the charging unit.
